Entry Rules

Eligibility as per 2018 Rulebook

All Qualifier Classes are Open to both senior and junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that has paid their membership for the current year.

For further eligibility rules please see Appendix CR 2 & 3 in the **BRC Handbook 2018**. It is the **responsibility** of the rider to ensure they are eligible for the classes entered. Those on borrowed horses should check eligibility on points and winnings.

Equine Influenza

Your horse must have up to date vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current rulebook. There is a checking device on the BRC Website, but if unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules in the current version of the BRC Rules. The full **2018** Rulebook is available to download online. If you have any query on the rules, please ring the BRC on 02476 840593.

ALL hats must have a visible **AQUA** hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show it meets the current safety standard. This can be from any discipline as per the new rules and there will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you.

Preliminary Entries

All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £29 per team or £9.50 per individual to the British Riding Clubs, Stoneleigh by Friday 16th February. Entry forms can be found on the BRC Website for postal entries (www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-downloads) or online entries can be made via the BHS (www.britishhorse.com/sections/riding-club-entries). Any entries made after this time may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been granted.

Objections and queries

Any queries should be addressed to the BRC Official Steward officiating at this event. Must be in writing and handed in. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit for £20. They must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident, or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.

Health & Safety Policy
