Area 1 Summer Qualifiers - ENTRY RULES

Club Representative / Team Manager - Each Club should nominate a Representative / Team Manager to co-ordinate entries, passports, declaration sheets, number collection, etc.

FOR AREA QUALIFIERS - All pre-entries (Team and Individual) must be made online through your Riding Club Representative / Team Manager to BRC HQ no later than **14th June 2024**. BRC HQ Pre-entry fees: **£48 per Team / £12.50 per individual**. ALL team members are automatically entered into the individual competition.

Ensure that names of riders and horses/ponies are correct at time of entry. Horse/Pony name **MUST** be as per passport. Microchip numbers **MUST** be supplied at time of entry. *If we have to contact you for missing or incorrect information there will be a £5 admin fee for each item.*

Successful entries will receive two confirmation e-mails - one from TicketTailor and one from PayPal.

Club Helpers - Each Club should provide one NON RIDING helper per team entered (and/or one helper per 4 individuals). Helper/Volunteer information **MUST** be completed online at time of entry.

Volunteer information must be provided at time of final entries. Any Clubs that do not provide named non-riding helpers plus contact details in advance will have one member disqualified per missing helper. Please note that the helpers are still required even if team or individuals withdraw.

Times on Area 1 website (www.brcarea1.co.uk) on Thursday 4th July (evening).

ANY changes to horse and/or rider after the times are published will incur a £5 fee per change.

Equine Passports: Team Managers / Competitors should take equine passports to the office on the day where spot checks will be undertaken. NO equine 'flu records will be checked in advance - it is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the vaccination record is correct.

Personal Information: You agree that we may publish your Personal Information as part of the results of events and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of qualification, insurance or for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events. Results may include (but not be limited to) name, club, times and age category.

All dressage classes are currently scheduled to run on a surface. Dispensation has been received for layout of dressage arenas.

COMPETITOR / TEAM MANAGER / CLUB CONTACT NOTES

All Classes will be in drawn order. Competition will start at approximately 9 am.

Timings – will be published on Area 1 website on Thursday 4th July (evening).

It is the **responsibility of each competitor** to ensure their horse vaccination record meets BRC rules and that they are eligible for classes entered.

If invalid documents, ineligible horse or rider is **declared BEFORE** the qualifier competition, all 4 riders can still compete but only 3 valid rider scores will count. If less than 3 are valid, the team may compete if space allows, but entry will be HC.

If any horse or rider at the qualifier is later found to be ineligible, then the **team will be eliminated**, with any qualification being passed to the next eligible team.

The club representative making entries must ensure that all details (classes, rider names, horse/pony names as per passport, microchip number, helpers, etc) are entered correctly. Errors on entries take up a great deal of time to resolve and may result in elimination of a team, or even all members of the Club. **If we have to contact you for missing or incorrect information there will be a £5 admin fee for each item.**

In the unlikely event of the event having to be cancelled, a percentage of the entry fee will be retained to cover admin and venue hire costs.

Please note Championship Invitations are issued by BRC Head Office - all results require to be verified.

ON THE DAY

IMPORTANT - Ideally the Team Manager/ designated Club member should bring the Completed Declaration Form(s) and all equine passports (spot check only) to the office and collect back numbers for ALL their club's members in plenty of time prior to them competing.

However, we understand that this is not always practicable. Competitors may bring their horse's passport and collect their back number but they will not be able to compete until the Declaration Forms have been submitted. The Team Manager may have to delegate handing over the Declaration Forms to another member of their Club.

Equine passports, plus any hats to be checked, should be brought to the office before competing and back numbers (which must be worn) should be collected.

OBJECTIONS - Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and handed to the Event Secretary. The protest must be accompanied by a deposit of £20.00. They must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest, or 30 minutes after the results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.
